

The City and Its Gender: Transverse Passages in Berlin

20 years after the multimedia tour *The City and Its Gender*, which explored latent gender-specific structures using the example of Munich, this concept is now being taken up in Berlin. We are looking for places that reflect relevant developments in both positive and negative ways. For example, International Women's Day has been declared a public holiday in Berlin, there is now the possibility of entering „diverse“ as gender in the birth register, and black feminism has been able to confidently inscribe itself in the city. However, this is contrasted with the broad upswing of right-wing movements, which is accompanied by racist defamation and a massive attack on women's rights, with anti-feminism proclaimed by right-wing extremist women as the real feminism. In response to this, the project exercises itself in pleasurable transverse passages that take stock of unexpected encounters connect.
