The focus is on women playing together on public places in Algeria. The oversized board game depicts on a small scale which gender-specific rules determine or restrict urban space in Algeria. How can women move, at what times, how visible are they and what places and roles are assigned to them? Women played in the cities of Algiers, Béjaia, Oran and Biskra to symbolically claim their share of public space.
